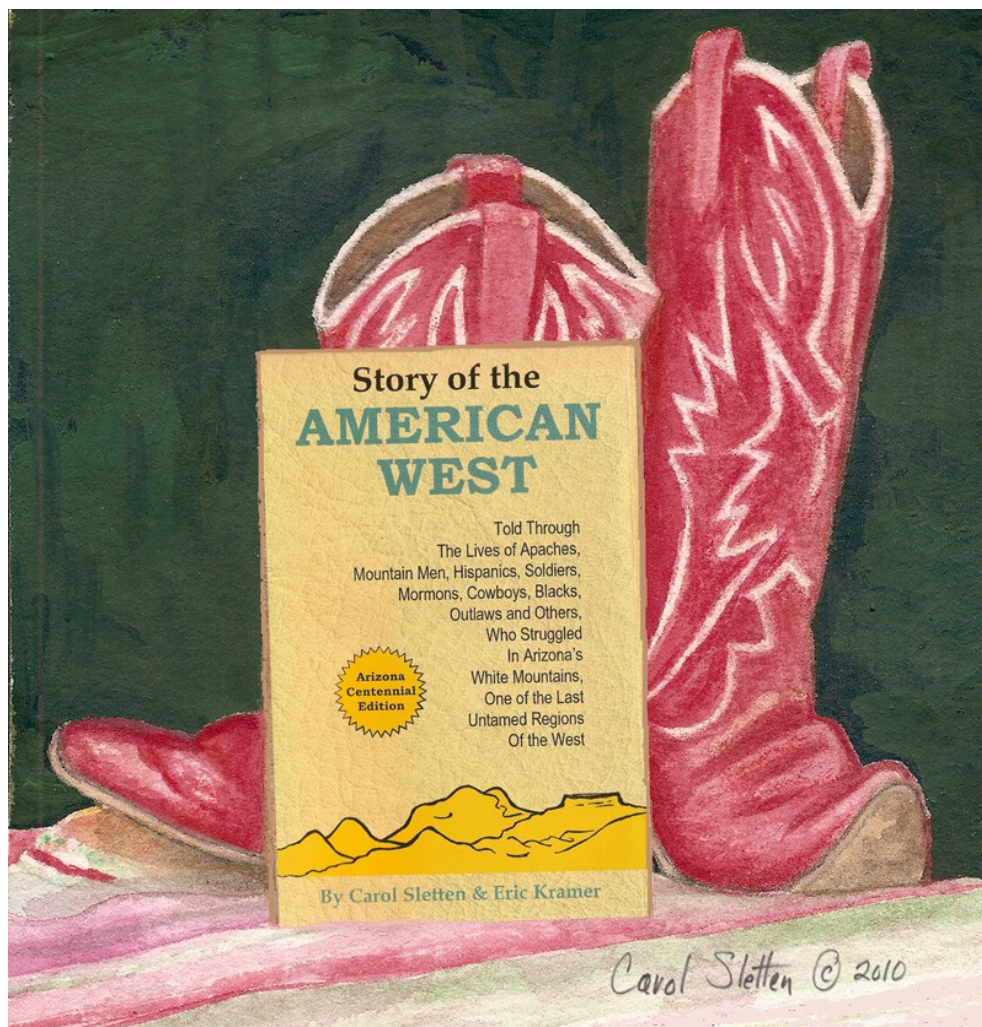


Carol Sletten - Words and Images
